Generations of families have paddled, hiked, camped, and connected with nature and Mi'kmaw culture at Kejimkujik National Park and National Historic Site. When the sun sets, the skies over Kejimkujik reveal a beautiful panorama of thousands of stars in Nova Scotia's only Dark-Sky Preserve. Rock engravings known as petroglyphs, traditional encampment areas, and canoe routes attest to the presence of the Mi'kmaw people for thousands of years.

Kejimkujik National Park Seaside is a separate protected wilderness on the Atlantic coast where you can experience pristine white sand beaches, astounding turquoise waters, coastal bogs, abundant wildflowers, rich lagoon systems, and coastal wildlife.

Kejimkujik offers a variety of camping experiences from front-country campsites for tents, roofed accommodation, trailers, and RVs to backcountry sites accessible by hiking, biking, or paddling.
